M/S ARTANIA

M/S Artania is a cruise ship with a capacity for 1200 passengers. The ship was built in 1984, Helsinki, Finland.

In the spring 2011, LiteCore A/S was the supplier of 96 teak flooring balconies to Norisol A/S, that were the contractors on the ship during renovation at Lloyd Werft in Bremerhaven, Germany.



SWISS JEWEL

The 118-passenger Swiss Jewel, sister ship to Swiss Sapphire and Swiss Emerald, debuted in April 2009. LiteCore was the supplier of LiteCore marine wall panels to Da Capo Scheepstimmerbedrijf.

The river vessel includes a main dining room, alternative "bistro" area offering lighter cuisine and a more casual vibe, a few bars, small fitness center and the obligatory sun deck.

All 59 cabins -- 38 standards, 14 suites and seven junior suites -- offer river views. Standard cabins and junior suites range from 150 to 183 square ft. and feature flat-screen TV's, mini-bar, safe and hair dryer. The 14 300-square-ft. suites boast upgraded upholstery, walk-in closets and marble baths.



SWISS SAPPHIRE

Swiss Sapphire, a newly built boat that joined the Tauck World Discovery fleet in 2008, is one of the river industry's newest entrants -- and it is full of little surprises. First, modern amenities and extras normally associated with coastal cruise ships and just starting to find their way into the river cruise world, come standard here (as well as on sister ships Swiss Jewel and Swiss Emerald). All cabins face the outside (most have French balconies).

LiteCore A/S have supplied wall panels for the newbuild in cooperation with H&P West and Da Capo Scheepstimmerbedrijf.



GRAND HOLYDAY

Grand Holyday was built in 1985 by Aalborg Yard, Denmark and is owned by Carnival Corporation & plc. The cruise ship has a capacity of 1.452 passengers.

LiteCore has delivered wall panels for the cruise ship under a renovation of the ship done by Euroinsulite in Italy.



M/N CELEBRATION

M/N Celebration was built in 1986 at Kockums Varv in Malmö, Sweden. The cruise ship has a capacity of 1,486 passengers and was owned by Iberocruceros since 2010.

LiteCore has supplied the M/N Celebration with wall panels during a renovation of the ship, where Euroinsulite Italy was a contractor.



M/Y REBORN

M/Y Reborn was built in 1999 at Amels Shipyard in Holland. The moter yacht have capacity to 14 guest.

In 2009/2010 the yacht was under refitting at Amico & Co. S.r.l Yard, Italy, designed by Sterling/Scott. Panels were delivered by LiteCore A/S to this refitting in cooperation with Euroinsulite, Italy.



M/S ALINA

On the 31st of March the new SCYLLA ship, MS ALINA, was baptised. The impressive ship with a length of 135 metres was waiting in Cologne to start sailing in the name of 'Phoenix Reisen', the charterer of the ship.

Both size and concept are revolutionising the river cruising industry. With its 108 cabins plenty of luxury is provided on the four star cruise-liner. The interior decoration is characterized by fashionable design. Brown upholstery with cyan cushions, dark wood panelling, straight lines.
